- √ Leitrim Association of People with Disabilities (LAPWD) is committed to complying with the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement at a board meeting
- √ LAPWD confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising by a statement to that effect in its annual report.
- √ LAPWD has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising
- √ LAPWD regularly monitors compliance with the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising and compliance reports are received regularly by the board
- √ LAPWD considers the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising when planning all fundraising activity.
- √ LAPWD has a policy on working with third party fundraisers (if applicable).
- √ LAPWD provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- √ LAPWD's Manager in conjunction with the board is responsible for compliance with the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising.
- √ LAPWD ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising and its implementation.
- √ LAPWD has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising. Feedback is recorded by relevant staff including the Manager and the board. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- √ LAPWD prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- √ LAPWD ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
- √ LAPWD is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
